The Pennsylvania State Police will accept unwanted, expired and unused prescription drugs on April 28 as part of National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day.

The service is free and anonymous; no questions are asked.

'The Drug Take-Back Program encourages consumers to get outdated or unused medications off of their shelves and out of the reach of children and teenagers," State Police Commissioner Frank Noonan said, noting that prescription drug abuse by teens

From 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Sat-

urday, unwanted or expired prescription medications may be dropped off at select State Police barracks. No personal information is required for drop-off.

Noonan said the program, conducted in partnership with the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration, also reduces the introduction of potentially harmful substances into the environment. As few disposal options exist, people tend flush medications down the toilet or toss them in the

Flushing medications can contribute to water pollution and poses serious health risks to water supplies and fish habitat. Disposing of medications in trashcans causes groundwater contamination through leaching out of landfills, harming wildlife that may ingest these drugs. It also could allow unauthorized persons to

have access to the medication. During a national drug takeback day held last fall, more than 188.5 tons of unwanted or expired medications were turned in at federal, state and local law enforcement sites.





### Flameworking Demonstration

The featured activity at the 2012 Lewisburg Arts Festival will be a glass flameworking demonstration highlighting the talents of master glass artist, Eric Goldschmidt, from the Corning Museum of Glass, at its Interactive Arts Park at Soldier's Memorial Park on North Water St. in Lewisburg, Pa. on Sat., April 28 from 10:30 a.m.- 5 p.m. During the show, Eric will melt the rods and tubes in the flame and then shape the softened glass into any variety of shapes, from glass animals to beads to ornaments, sculptures and vessels with a raffle and give-away every 30 minutes starting

at 10:30 a.m. Flameworking is the technique of forming objects from rods and tubes of glass that, when heated in a flame, become soft and can be manipulated into the desired shape. The flameworking technique probably dates back to ancient times. It was known in France and Venice in the 15th century, and it has been practiced ever since. Originally, the source of the flame was an oil or paraffin lamp. Today, flameworkers use torches fueled with gas. Flameworking was the first glassworking technique demonstrated at the Museum, and it continues to be demonstrated there

Previous to his current position, Eric was the resident flameworker at The Studio of The Corning Museum of Glass and a flameworker for Arribas Brothers Company at Disney World.



Letters Written During WW1 From Jay A. Rigel to Family and Friends

April 27, 2012, Union County Times -3

Letter to: Brother and all (not in an envelope) Top of letterhead reads:

'On Active Service with The American Expeditionary Force" Date: October 5, 1918 Location: France

Dear Brother and all, Will try and write a few lines this evening.

I expect to go to the Y.M.C.A. They are having a show tonight. I was there last evening. They had a good show. The weather has changed in the last two weeks. We had several

frosts and the nights are cool. I suppose you are real busy. Sorry to hear the boys went home.

I am on the old job yet, driving a team. We haul the commissary to the companies. We drive to a town 8 kilometers from here for the commissary.

I suppose you see a great many troops pass. They are sent east from the western camps. I did not see today's paper but there is good news every day. We are looking for the Americans to capture (this had been erased) very soon. Hope they will suc-

You ought to hear us talk French. We know how to say, "I do not understand" in French. That is about all we can and do say. Ha.

I will send two souvenirs along. One for Roy and Edna and one for Chas and Esther. I will send one or two in each letter for the rest. Let me know if you get them.

Write and let me know how you are getting along. I am well. Hope all are the same. My love to all

who read and censored the letter. Not only was the war going on, but this was also the time of the

worldwide influenza epidemic, which started in January of 1918. The Army nurses played a critical role in this deadly epidemic It was (and remains) the single most deadly epidemic in modern times. It is now estimated that more than 50 million people around the globe died as a result of having the flu. People living and working in crowded army posts and port towns were very susceptible, as it was very contagious. The increase in travel also caused it to spread. Many of the victims were healthy young adults in the age range of 20 to 40. Incredibly, more than half of this age group who had the disease, died from it. More than 200 Army nurses who contracted influenza while


