Buffalo Valley Community Band Performance- On Saturday, June 13 at 2:00 pm, get your toes tapping with a performance by the Buffalo Valley Community Band. It's part Buggy Day Street Fair held at 5th & Market Streets in Mifflinburg. Attendance is free. Donations are encouraged.

"1776: The Musical"- RiverStage Community Theatre presents the classic musical "1776" at Greenspace Center, 815 Market Street, Lewisburg on June 19, 20 and 27 at 7:30 pm. There will be a special 6pm performance on Friday June 26 to allow time to spectators to attend the Union County Veterans' 4th of July Drone Light and Fireworks Show. There will also be two Sunday matinees on June 21 and 28 starting at 2:30 pm. Tickets are \$15 for adults and \$8 for students, with general admission seating. Tickets can be purchased at the door or at www.riverstage.com. This production is supported by a generous grant from the America250PA Foundation.

Community Concert/Drone Light and Fireworks Show- The Union County Veterans' 4th of July Fireworks show gets a new twist this year with the Region's first drone light show. On Friday, June 26, 250 drones (for 250 years) will light up the sky over Lewisburg followed by the amazing pyrotechnics display from Bixler Pyrotechnics. The party gets started at Wolfe Field in Lewisburg with local food vendors at 5 pm. Lucky Afternoon Band starts the music at 7 pm. Sunbury Broadcasting keeps the beat until dusk before the launching of the aerial program. Rain dates for this event are June 27 and June 28. Feature sponsors include Weis Markets, Geisinger, WellSpan Evangelical and America250PA.

Most Patriotic Float Competition- For the 5th year, community

groups participating in the Union County Veterans' 4th of July parade can enter their float to win the Sgt. Thomas Reimensnyder Patriot Award. The award goes to the most patriotic float in the parade and brings with it a \$250 cash prize sponsored by C&N Bank and a unique trophy designed and created by students at SUN Area Technical School.

Veterans' Gala Parade- On Saturday, June 27 at 10 am, the Union County Veterans' 4th of July Gala Parade begins with a scheduled flyover by the Douglas C-47 Skytrain, "Luck of the Irish". The parade honors over 100 veterans and features over 250 entries including marching bands, first responders and different makers in our communities as well as other surprises. This is a rain or shine event.

Train Rides- Following the Veterans' Gala Parade, North Shore Railroad will be offering train rides. There will be two rides. One departing Hufnagle Park at 1:30 pm and another departing at 3:30 pm. The ride goes from Lewisburg to Winfield and back and is about an hour long. The passenger train will be pulled by LVRR 9052 (Veterans Unit) and NSHR 2238 (Semiquincentennial Locomotive). Tickets for the rides are \$25 per person and can be purchased through ucveterans4thofjuly.org or northshorewarehouse.com/veterans-4th with half of the ticket sales returning to Celebration.

Together, let's make 2026 a celebration worthy of 1776 — honoring our freedoms, our veterans, and the next 250 years of American spirit.

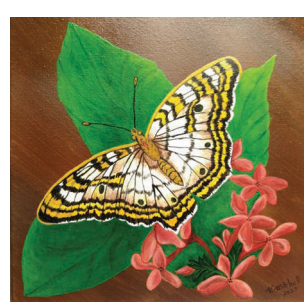

Bittner Becomes First to Repeat in RaceSaver Sprints at Clinton County Speedway

Mill Hall, PA – Timmy Bittner of Beech Creek became the first driver to win two River Valley Builders RaceSaver Sprint Car feature events this season. The winner of opening day, returned to victory lane on Friday night. Following the restart, Bittner kept Weaver's challenges at bay to maintain his lead. With five laps to go Bittner was still leading Weaver, Schweikart, Beamer and Tebbs. By lap 22, Bittner had caught the rear of the field and had to navigate lapped traffic. Bittner held on for with victory over Weaver, Schweikart, Beamer and Tebbs.

AY Schilling of Linden led the first two laps of the Pro Stocks feature event. Cory Long, who started sixth, charged to the front and took the lead by the completion of lap number three. At the halfway mark Long was leading Kyler Stahl, Schilling, AJ Hoffman and Brent Gordor. Hoffman worked his way up through the field and took over second on lap number nine. Stahl battled with Schilling with Schilling taking the third spot on lap number ten. Long continued to lead the final five laps to claim the win over Hoffman, Schilling, Gordor and Stahl.

Michael Petock started on the pole and led the opening laps of the 270 Micro feature event. Cory Stabley advanced from the third spot into second place. Mac Wert took the third position on lap number six. A lap eight caution flag bunched the field up behind Petock, Wert was able to use the restart to pass Stabley. On lap 10 Stabley was involved in a caution, moving Wert into second. Mechanical misfortune would end Petock's night allowing Wert to restart first with only five laps to go. Wert brought the field back to green flag racing with Devin Dunmire, Denny Rhinehimer, Mason McAndrew and Garrison Zook in the top five. Wert would hold on for the final five laps to earn his second consecutive feature event. Dunmire, Rhinehimer, McAndrew and Zook rounded out the top five.

Kevin Trimpey led the first two laps of the SC-DRA Four Cylinder feature event. Richard Eldred took over the lead on lap number three. By half way through the race, Zak Kline charged from 12th into the lead. Kline started last, after rolling his primary car in the heat race. The team ran back to their race shop for a second car to compete in the race. Kline took the lead on lap number six. Jimmy Moyer passed Eldred for second on lap number ten. Kline and Moyer battled for the lead, with Kline earning the win over Moyer, Eldred, Coty Maines, and Tim Raup

Jersey Shore's Emery Macgill led every lap of the Rising Stars Jr Sprint feature event. Tyreece Bowmaster and Adilyn Bathurst completed the top three.

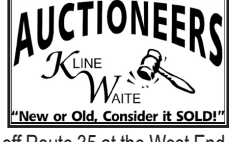

Satterlee goes Three for Three in SLM Points Races; Myers, Bruno and Bitter Score Selinsgrove Victories

...he brought his back-up four-cylinder car to the track with him on Friday night. He flipped his regular ride in the heat race, got the back-up car ready for the feature started last in the field and came on strong to score the feature win. The car that Zak flipped was going to race at a big SCDRA race at Winchester, Va. Speedway on Saturday, instead of using his backup car he was going to stay up all night and fix his wrecked car. Unfortunately for Kline, with 50 drivers on hand he was not able to make the feature line-up, but it was for not putting in a big effort to get it done. How about the Dewease family both winning on the same night. Lance won for the 117 time at Williams Grove in the 410 sprints while his son Cole scored his first ever 305-sprint feature win on the same night at the same track. Lincoln Speedway on Saturday night it was another win for Chase Dietz for his fifth win of the season at Lincoln. Freddie Rahmer was second with Australian driver Ryan Newton third followed by Troy Wagaman Jr and Cameron Smith. In 358-sprint car action there was a new winner after Cody Fletcher won the first four features Jayden Wolf scored the feature win over Cameron Merriman, Steve Qwings, Eli Tuckey and Cody Fletcher. This Friday and Saturday Williams Grove and Lincoln will host the ALL STAR sprint car series for the second year in a row. Last year Lance Dewease won the race at Williams Grove over Danny Dietrich, and Ryan Smith, while at Lincoln Danny Dietrich scored the win over Troy Wagaman Jr and Tim Shaffer. Last year the grove had 40-sprint while Lincoln had 44.

Saturday at Selinsgrove speedway it was a busy night with four divisions in action, it was a well-run show with no long breaks in between events, the East Coast sprint feature went non-stop with the super late model and Limited late models only having one caution in their feature races. Gregg Satterlee pretty much owns Selinsgrove speedway scoring his third feature win four races so far this year Satterlee has 180 points lead over Ross Robinson, 190 over Jeff Rine, 290 over Andrew Yoder with Rick Eckert last years champ another 315 back. Satterlee made a good move at the start of the feature to go from his third starting spot to the lead before turn one, he led all 25-laps for the win over Trevor Feathers who was making his first Selinsgrove start this year. Feathers beat Satterlee Friday night at Bedford speedway, while both nights found Matt Cosner in third place. Fourth at Selinsgrove was Rick Eckert then Ross Robinson. In the limited late model feature DJ Myers of Greencastle scored his first ever late model feature win leading most of the way in the 20-lap feature. Myers who has driven super late models in the past, but is now focused on the limited class, and building cars called TRW chassis, Myers was followed by Andrew Yoder, Jaxton Garman who has one of the Myers build cars and George Dixon Jr. In the sprint car part of the show Christian Bruno won a heated battle with Steve Drevicki for the 20-lap feature win over Kyle Spence, Ronald Helmick and Kenny Miller III. The East Coast sprint will be back at Selinsgrove this Friday night along with the 305-sprints and limited late models. In the 305-sprint feature Timmy Bittner was followed by Mike Alleman, Mike Melair, Doug Dodson and Tyler Schell. This Thursday the 410-sprint will be back to the track for the third time this season. AJ Flick filling for Mike Walter won the first race in the Knable #77, while Mark Smith won the other feature over Chase Dietz, Austin Bishop, Ryan Taylor and Kody Lehman. The Street Stocks will also be racing for the third time with Jason Geesaman and Troy Miller scoring the feature wins.

Cold temperatures and 20-plus mph winds made conditions tough Saturday night at Selinsgrove Speedway, but the racing still delivered. Indiana's Gregg Satterlee stayed perfect in Selinsgrove Ford Super Late Model point races, Christian Bruno scored his first career USAC East Coast win at Selinsgrove, Greencastle's DJ Myers earned his first Creekside Autosales Limited Late Model victory, and Beech Creek's Timmy Bittner won the Keller's Auto Body PASS 305 feature.

Twenty-six Super Late Models signed in, with Trevor Feathers and defending champion Rick Eckert leading the field to green. By turn two, however, Satterlee had already powered into the lead using what remained of the middle groove. Once out front, he was untouchable.

Satterlee expertly handled lap traffic while Ridgely, West Virginia's Matt Cosner worked his way forward, eventually taking third from Eckert late in the race. The event's only caution flew when Greg Diehl spun in turns one and two, setting up a green-white-checker finish. Satterlee again pulled away to claim his 11th career Selinsgrove Super Late Model win over Feathers, Cosner, Eckert, and Ross Robinson.

"We made about 8 to 10 laps around the middle," Satterlee said in victory lane. "We've got a really good balance here. We love coming out here."

The USAC East Coast Wingless 360 Sprint Cars returned to Selinsgrove for the first time since 2022, and despite a rubbered-up surface, fans were treated to a thrilling finish. Ronald Helmick and Ed Aikin brought the field to green, but Steven Drevicki stormed to the lead by lap three and set the pace.

Starting eighth, Deptford, New Jersey's Christian Bruno steadily carved through the field, using every inch of the racetrack and gaining ground through lap traffic. Drevicki held strong through the middle stages, even navigating slower cars with a daring four-wide move, but Bruno kept closing.

As the laps wound down, Bruno found momentum on the outside where few others could run. He reached Drevicki's rear bumper, completed the winning pass late, and drove away for his second consecutive USAC East Coast victory after winning at Big Diamond the previous week. Drevicki finished second, followed by Kyle Spence, Helmick, and Kenny Miller III.

Nineteen Creekside Autosales Limited Late Models presented by Cristwell's Towing were on hand for their third race of the season. DJ Myers and Meade Hahn started on the front row, with Myers immediately taking command. Behind him, Andrew Yoder charged from sixth to third on the opening lap, while George Dixon and Jaxton Garman battled for position.

Out front, however, Myers was in complete control. In a dominant, flag-to-flag performance, he became the third different winner in three Limited Late Model races this season. Yoder, Garman, Dixon, and Shaun Miller completed the top five.

"I was surprised," Myers said. "Even with the track rubbered down, it was still a beautiful track and great racing."

The Keller's Auto Body PASS 305 Sprint Car feature saw Timmy Bittner continue his hot streak. Fresh off a win at Clinton County Speedway, Bittner worked from fourth to second early but trailed race-long leader Mike Alleman for much of the event.

With five laps remaining, traffic slowed Alleman

just enough for Bittner to slip underneath and take the lead. A late caution gave Alleman one final chance, but Bittner nailed the restart and pulled away to secure his first Selinsgrove victory and fourth overall PASS win. Alleman finished second, followed by Mike Melair, Doug Dodson, and Tyler Schell.

Selinsgrove Speedway returns June 4-5 with a doubleheader featuring the Kramer Cup for the 410 Sprint Cars and Military Appreciation Night with USAC East Coast Sprints, Limited Late Models, and PASS 305s.
