Keller Announces He Will Not Seek Re-Election

On February 28, 2022, Congressman Fred Keller (R-PA) announced that he will not seek re-election. The district map was redrawn and the 12th District now overlaps with U.S. Rep. Glenn Thompson in northwestern Pennsylvania and includes Snyder and Union counties. Running in the 9th District, would pit Keller against U.S. Rep. Dan Meuser. After consideration, Keller announced that he will not challenge Congressman Meuser for the 9th District seat in the newly redrawn map.



Keller released the following statement: "With control of Congress—and the direction of our nation—at stake, this election is bigger than any one person. Rather than pit Republicans against Republicans, which the congressional map chosen by the liberal Pennsylvania Supreme Court does, I am committed to helping take back the House, holding Pennsylvania's U.S. Senate seat, and electing a conservative Governor. To that end, I am not going to run against another member of Pennsylvania's Republican Congressional Delegation."

"The liberal Pennsylvania Supreme Court did the Commonwealth a great injustice when it once again overstepped its authority and selected a partisan map favoring Democrats. Make no mistake, this map—submitted by a national Democrat group—intends to diminish the voices of conservative voters in central and northeast Pennsylvania. As I said last week, I am not going to let that happen."

"I have always promised to take the values of the people I represent to government. Those values include God, family, country, hard work and honesty. My lifetime of work has reflected that."

"My team and I will continue to work to provide the constituents of Pennsylvania's 12th Congressional District with the highest level of service. Representing the values of the outstanding people of central and northeast Pennsylvania, who go to work every day and get the job done, has been the privilege of a lifetime. Thank you to everyone who has allowed me to do it."

"We have two scripts in mind, and the turnout for auditions will help us determine which show we'll do," director Joyce Hendricks noted. "Both plays are excellent showcases for the talent we know is out there in our region."

The first play possibility is "Delval Divas" by Barbara Pease Weber, which features six female roles (ages range from 30-50).

Stella, Rosemary, Linda and Beth have some things in common: besides being educated, successful, professional women, they also share the same address — not a swanky high rise apartment building or a beachfront condo — they reside at the Delaware Valley Federal Correctional Facility, a low-level security prison for white- and "pink-" collar criminals. With the warden in one pocket and their cell block guard in another, the "Divas" continue to indulge their lavish and luxurious lifestyles until Beth is prematurely released and a murderess moves into her place. Adding insult to injury, the Department of Corrections has announced its intention to close the Delval facility due to mismanagement and relocate inmates to the less-than-glamorous Black Rock Federal Prison. How do the Divas save Delval, solve a murder and maintain their lifestyle? Who ever said that crime doesn't pay?

The second play in contention is Crazy Quilt Club by Pat Cook. This play features eight female roles (ages range from 40-50) and one male role.

Veronica is a whodunit author who spends most of her time knitting and solving murders, most of which occur whenever she shows up. Understandably she has a problem finding a place to live. Her niece finds her a place to stay at a "retirement home," although none of the residents is actually of retirement age. They all however have their "personality quirks." It seems ideal until one of its members dies from drinking poisoned punch. Who did it? Was it Matilda, the president of the Crazy Quilt Club, or Lydia, who likes to "die" on Tuesdays? Could it be Clara, a compulsive liar, or the wisecracking Sarafina who doesn't trust anybody? Clues drop as fast as corpses and dialogue races along at breakneck speed.

FCFP Awards Grant To Lewisburg Borough

The First Community Foundation Partnership of Pennsylvania (FCFP) recently awarded \$2,600 to Lewisburg Borough in support of its on-going improvements associated with the Bull Run Greenway Project at Hufnagle Park. The grant funds for the project are from the Lindig Lewisburg Foundation Fund and are specifically designated for the installation of shade trees for the Kidsburg playground area and a split-rail fence to be located adjacent to the active railroad near the Kidsburg playground area.

The current Bull Run Greenway is phase one of a multi-phase project to improve Hufnagle Park, with new amenities, improved pedestrian mobility, and environmental enhancement. "We are proud to announce that the First Community Foundation Partnership of Pennsylvania has become a partner in this transformative project for Lewisburg," said Steven Beattie, Lewisburg Borough Community Development/Grant Manager.

The entire project is funded by multiple sources including the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Playworld, and funds from Lewisburg Borough. "This additional funding from the FCFP will help us realize our plan to construct a wooden split-rail fence along the railroad south of St. Louis Street," said Beattie. "Additionally, our ability to plant three shade trees to compliment the new Kidsburg playground is a positive for all future playground visitors."

In addition to the construction currently underway on the Borough's Mixed-Use Path/Nature Play/Floodplain restoration project, Lewisburg Borough is also coordinating the construction of the Hufnagle Park Restroom and Handwashing Station Project in the same area of the park where portable toilets previously were located. Furthermore, Lewisburg Borough is working with Playworld on their recently announced completely new, world-class playground at Hufnagle Park to replace the Kidsburg playground that has existed in the park since 1999.

The FCFP works to improve the quality of life in north central Pennsylvania through community leadership, the promotion of philanthropy, the strengthening of non-profit impact and the perpetual stewardship of charitable assets. FCFP strives to create powerful communities through passionate giving. "This project enhancement is one part of a larger park and stream corridor project first envisioned in 2017," Beattie stated. "We appreciate our partnership with FCFP and the other partners and look forward to future phases to continue implementation of the Lewisburg community's vision."
