## Benjamin R. Smith of Mifflinburg, Promoted to Lieutenant Colonel



Benjamin R. Smith, formerly of Mifflinburg was recently promoted to the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Air Force Reserve. A 2001 graduate of Mifflinburg Area High School, Lt Col Smith served for over 12 years on active duty after graduating and earning his commission from the United States Air Force Academy in 2005. He earned his Air Force pilot wings in 2006 upon completion of Air Force Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training at Columbus Air Force Base, MS where he conducted initial flight training in the T-37 "Tweet" and the T-1 "Jayhawk."

Lt Col Smith's operational flying assignments include Hickam Air Force Base, Hawaii and Joint Base Charleston, South Carolina where he flew the C-17 "Globemaster III" heavy transport aircraft. He has over 3,300 flight hours in the C-17 and has commanded numerous humanitarian relief, aeromedical evacuation, presidential support and airdrop missions around the world. He has deployed multiple times in support of a variety of overseas contingency operations; amassing over 800 combat flight hours and completing more than 100 combat missions.

Smith's last active duty assignment was to Columbus AFB, MS, where he taught Air Force pilot candidates and flew more than 1,100 hours in the T-6 "Texan II" as an instructor and evaluator pilot in addition to serving as a Flight Commander and Operations Group Standardization and Evaluation Officer. Since completing his active duty service commitment, Lt Col Smith continues to serve as a C-17 pilot for the Air Force Reserves while working as an airline pilot operating the Airbus A320 family of aircraft for a legacy US carrier. Ben is the son of Dan and Anne Smith of Mifflinburg and the grandson of Pat and Ken Smith of Mifflinburg. He lives in South Carolina with his wife and children.

## Jonah Carney & Katie Kelley Accepted Into All-National Honors Choir

**Congratulations to Katie Kelley and Jonah Carney of Lewisburg Area High School were accepted into the All-National Honors Choir.**

Two Lewisburg Area High School students, Jonah Carney (Tenor 2) and Katie Kelley (Soprano 1), were accepted into the 2022 National Association for Music Education (NAFME) All-National Mixed Choir. The choir, along with 5 other national music ensembles, will gather in Washington DC, November 3-6, 2022.

"I'm so excited to be participating in an All-National Honor Ensemble! I've performed in choirs of a wide variety of levels, even beyond PMEA divisions, but to be a part of an ensemble of this caliber is something I never thought I'd experience. I am extremely grateful for all the support I've received from my community thus far; it is that support that has afforded me this opportunity," said Katie enthusiastically.

Katie is hosting a benefit concert to raise funds to cover the cost of registration. The concert will take place on October 22 at 7 pm in the Lewisburg Area High School, with donations accepted. The concert will feature a duet between the two qualifying students, Katie and Jonah.

Jonah Carney participated in All-National Choir in 2021, and recent graduate Ryan Shabahang qualified as an alternate; the two were the first students from Lewisburg Area High School ever to reach that level in choir. Because that event was virtual, Katie Kelley will be the first Lewisburg student to attend an All-National Honor Ensemble event in person.

All-National Honor Ensembles are the next step beyond the three Pennsylvania Music Educators' Association (PMEA) festival levels of District, Regional, and All-State. Lewisburg Area High School sent 12 students to All-State festivals this spring: Kiran Bedi, Haley Berge, Jonah Carney, Liam Cummings, Summer Evans, Ryan Gilmore, Katie Kelley, Isabelle Kim, Andrew Nicholls, Ryan Shabahang, Erich Stiner, and Micah Zook.

NAFME is one of the world's largest arts education organizations; it has operated at local, state, and national levels since 1907, and addresses all aspects of music education. According to the NAFME website, "The NAFME All-National Honor Ensembles represent the top performing high school musicians in the United States. So much more than a musical showcase, the ANHE program is a comprehensive and educational experience."

The 9th Annual Snader Strong 5K will be held on Saturday, September 24 at 9 am and kicks off the Market Street Festival. The race begins at the intersection of Pine Street & Market Street and heads down to the Susquehanna Rive for scenic running views along the Que. This completely flat course is ideal for walkers, joggers, and competitive runners. Come and test your fitness at the Snader Strong 5K.  
Race day registration will be held from 7:30-8:45 am. Race starts at 9 am. Awards ceremony will be held immediately following the race in the middle of the Market Street Festival. \$25 per participant.  
During an accident sliding into a shallow pond, Tyler Snader shattered his 7th spinal vertebra and fractured his 5th and 6th vertebrae. After surgery, the muscles below Tyson's chest are expected to remain paralyzed. He is beginning physical therapy in Philadelphia and hopes to defy all odds. Tyler Snader has a free-spirited, fun-loving, and optimistic outlook on life. He was a star on the Township CC team and went on to run at Susquehanna University.

Tyler has a wife Lacey and son Hudson. The family faces many financial challenges including uninsured medical expenses, creating an accessible home, purchasing an accessible vehicle, and providing ongoing care throughout Tyler's recovery. The family appreciates the support, thoughts, and prayers during this difficult time.

Hosted by The Mifflinburg & Selinsgrove Cross Country Teams, net proceeds from the race will benefit the Christopher and Dana Reeve Foundation for curing spinal cord injuries and the booster clubs for the Selinsgrove and Mifflinburg Cross Country teams.





Austin Reed of Etters powered to his first career win at Selinsgrove Speedway in Saturday night's PA Game Commission "Race To Hunting Season" 25-lap championship race for the PASS 305 sprint cars.

Dylan Yoder of Middleburg became the third driver to repeat a super late model win at the track this year in the division's 25-lap main event, while Trent Brenneman of Mifflintown scored his first win of the season in the 20-lap limited late model race.

Keith Bissinger of Orangeville was also a first-time winner this year in the 12-lap roadrunner feature.

Selinsgrove Speedway will close out the 2022 season with the two-day 40th National Open for 410 sprint cars Friday and Saturday, Sept. 23-24. Friday night's race will feature the 410 sprint cars and super late models starting at 7:45 p.m. Saturday night's finale will be the 40-lap Jim Nace Memorial National Open paying \$26,000 to win plus the PASS 305 sprint cars at 7 p.m.

Austin Reed started on the pole for the 305 sprint car championship race and was trailed by second-place starter Erin Statler and sixth-place starter Josh Spicer.

The race's only caution flag unfurled on lap 17 when Doug Dodson's car made contact with the guardrail in turns one and two. For the restart, Reed continued to set a torrid pace in front of Spicer while a wheel-to-wheel battle unfolded for third between 10th-place starter Logan Spahr and eighth-place starter Garrett Bard.

At the checkered flag, Reed was victorious by 1.6 seconds over Spicer, Bard, Spahr, and 12th-place starter Christian Rumsey.

Polesitter Dylan Yoder powered into the lead at the start of the super late model feature. D. Yoder was chased by fourth-place starter Andrew Yoder with second-place starter Jim Bernheisel and sixth-place starter Jeff Rine in close pursuit.

Third-place starter Bryan Bernheisel showed some speed at the half-way point after dropping back a few spots on the start and advanced to second. B. Bernheisel became D. Yoder's most serious challenger to the finish.

At the checkered flag, D. Yoder was victorious by just one second over B. Bernheisel, Rine, A. Yoder, and J. Bernheisel.

A former go kart champion on Selinsgrove's one-fifth mile track, A. Yoder wrapped up his first track championship on the half-mile track in the limited late model division.

Second-place starter Dan Condo led through lap nine in the roadrunner feature until he drifted high in turns three and four and allowed fifth-place starter Keith Bissinger to make the winning pass.

Condo and fourth-place starter Nate Romig duelled for second only to fall off the pace due to flat tires from contact. At the finish, Bissinger scored the win over Bob Bussey, Scott Dunham, Cory Lindenmuth, and Tom Underwood.
