Hurricane Agnes & The Flood of 1972 Hit 50 Years Ago

June 24, 1972 at 34.6 ft. By Sunday, people began returning to their homes to assess the damage. In addition to lives lost and people forced to leave their homes, flood damage affected homes, businesses, farmlands, livestock, bridges, and roadways.

CSVT Northern Section Public Event For Pedestrians

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) will open a portion of the Northern Section of the Central Susquehanna Valley Transportation (CSVT) Project to the public for a one-time event prior to its anticipated opening to traffic in July.

On Saturday, June 25, between the hours of 10 am-3 pm, the public will be permitted to walk and bicycle along a section of the new roadway and river bridge to get a close-up look at this unique project. No vehicles will be permitted within the walking/biking area.

What to expect:

- The entrance and exit for the event will be at the new interchange at Ridge Road in Point Township, Nor-

thumberland County. Flaggers will be directing traffic and assisting with parking.

- The parking area is approximately a half mile from the river bridge. The bridge is almost a mile long. Anticipate a moderate walking/biking distance.

- There will be approximately 3.5 miles of roadway open to the public to walk and bicycle (7 miles round trip).

- Entrance will be permitted from 10 am- 2 pm with the event ending at 3 pm.

- The public will be required to sign a waiver when entering the project area. The waiver will be available to review and sign prior to the event at <http://www.csvt.com> and copies will be available at a sign in table during the event.

Driving Directions

- From Interstate 80
 - Exit 212A – South Route 147
 - Proceed 9 miles south
 - Turn Left at traffic signal onto Ridge Road (Route 1024)
 - Proceed 0.5 miles
 - Pass under CSVT
 - Turn Left onto the new on ramp and following directions to parking area

- From Harrisburg
 - North on Routes 11/ 15
 - Right Turn onto Route 11 North at Routes 11/15 split in Shamokin Dam
 - Left turn onto Route 147 North in Northumberland
 - Turn Right at traffic signal onto Ridge Road (Route 1024)
 - Proceed 0.5 miles
 - Pass under CSVT
 - Turn Left onto the new on ramp and following directions to parking area

Many area television stations and historical societies are focusing their coverage on recalling the flood efforts, damage, and after-effects of the Agnes Flood that hit the area in June 1972. This is a 50 year trip down memory lane recalling that devastating time. Thoughts of the Presidential campaign between incumbent Republican Richard Nixon and Democratic U.S. Senator George McGovern disappeared into the background as the torrential rain hit followed by the rising flood waters.

On Wednesday, June 21, the rainfall total reached 10 inches in a 12-hour period, with more heavy rainfall predicted. On Thursday, June 22, Governor Milton J. Shapp declared a state of emergency in all flooded areas. Many towns were completely surrounded by water as the Susquehanna River and tributaries overflowed their banks. Evacuation centers offered shelter and curfews were put in place.

On Friday, June 23, 1972, the flood waters forced the evacuation of resident at the Isle of Que and along the Old Trail. The flood waters wreaked devastating damage. Power shortages hit the area.

The Susquehanna River crested on Saturday morning,

The super late models will compete in a 25-lap feature paying \$3,000 to win. Six races to date have produced six different winners, with Gregg Satterlee of Rochester Mills picking up the most recent in the 24th Late Model Open last Saturday.

The limited late models will be back for the third time this season in a 20-lap feature paying \$1,200 to win. Andrew Yoder of Middleburg will be seeking the "three-peat" as he swept the events last Saturday, including his second feature win of the season, heat win, and a victory in the Lil' Bob's Dash for Cash.

Making their annual appearance at the track, the mid-Atlantic modifieds will race a 20-lap feature. Last year former NAS-CAR racer David Stremme scored the division's win at the track.

In the spotlight this Saturday will be the pro stocks in the division's first return to the track since Aug. 24, 2019, when Brandon Moser of Middleburg won the last race. The family of the late C.W. Smith of Williamsport has put together a memorial race to honor one of the speedway's former champions. The 28-lap tribute race will pay \$1,800 to win and \$225 to start out of the \$9,000 purse.

The pro stock division continues to run regularly at the Clinton County Speedway in Lock Haven. The C.W. Smith Memorial will run under the Clinton County technical rules that can be reviewed at clintoncountyspeedway.com/pro-stock.

C.W. Smith started his racing career at Selingsgrove in 1983 and won the 1987 limited late model track championship. He moved into the ARCA and Busch Series stock cars from 1994 through 2005. When he retired from driving, he continued as a car owner and crew chief for his son Jason's racing career from 2005 through 2016 in Selingsgrove's pro stock division. Together, they won the 2009 pro stock track championship. C.W. passed away in November of 2017 at the age of 70.
